SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Code by adding provisions for regulation of cable television basic service rates and charges.

BILL NO. <u>/073</u> ORDINANCE NO. <u>898</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 OF THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY ADDING PROVISIONS FOR THE REGULATION OF CABLE TELEVISION BASIC SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Chapter 90 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance.

SECTION 2.

90.271 Purpose and authority.

1. On October 5, 1992, the United States Congress enacted the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992 which, among other things, provided that the basic service tier rates, and the charges for related equipment, installation and services, of a cable television system shall be subject to regulation by a franchising authority in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The FCC prescribed such regulations on April 1, 1993, in the Report and Order, In the Matter of Implementation of Sections of Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992: Rate Regulation, MM Docket 92-266, FCC 93-177 (released May 3, 1993, referred to herein as the "FCC Rate Regulations").

2. The County of Washoe desires to regulate the Basic Service Rates and Charges for companies holding franchises issued by the county to operate cable television systems in Washoe County; and the county shall do so in accordance with the FCC Rate Regulations, notwithstanding any different or inconsistent provisions in any fran-chises granted by the county or as otherwise

provided herein.

SECTION 3.

90.272 <u>Regulation of basic service rates and charges.</u>

1. The county will follow the FCC Rate Regulations

in its regulation of the Basic Service Rates and Charges of every cable television system operating in the county, notwithstanding any different or inconsistent provisions in a franchise.

In connection with such regulation, as set forth in subsection 1 above, the county will ensure a reasonable opportunity for consideration of the views of inter-

ested parties.

The county manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute on behalf of the county and file with the FCC such certification forms or other instruments as are now or may hereafter be required by the FCC Rate Regulations in order to enable the county to regulate Basic Service Rates and Charges.
