(Limited Tax) Convention Center Refunding Bonds (Additionally Secured with Pledged Revenues) Series 2001A (the "2001A Bonds") and (b) the Washoe County, Nevada (Reno-Sparks Convention & Visitors Authority) General Obligation (Limited Tax) Multi-Purpose Bowling Facility Refunding Bonds (Additionally_Secured with Pledged Revenues) Series 2001B (the "2001B Bonds" and together with the 2001A Bonds, the "Refunding Bonds"); and

(4) WHEREAS, pursuant to the NRS 244A.597 to 244A.655 as amended (the "Recreation Act") and NRS 350.500 to 350.720 as amended (the "Bond Act"), the Authority has adopted a resolution authorizing the issuance of the 2001A Bonds and a resolution authorizing the issuance of the 2001B Bonds, copies of which have been filed with the County, authorizing the issuance of the Refunding Bonds (the "Refunding Bond Resolutions").

- Section 5. <u>Filing Ordinance</u>. A certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed forthwith with the Secretary of the Authority.
- Section 6. <u>Ordinance Irrepealable</u>. This ordinance shall be and shall remain irrepealable until the Refunding Bonds or any bonds refunding the Refunding Bonds shall be fully paid, canceled and discharged, or until provision shall be made therefor, in the manner provided in the Refunding Bond Resolutions.
- Section 7. <u>Publication and Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication as hereinafter provided, and after this ordinance is signed by the Chairman of the Board and attested and sealed by the County Clerk, this ordinance shall be published by title
