AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY ADDING THERETO PROVISIONS AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO DISCOUNT FEES AND OFFER SPECIAL GROUP RATES FOR USE OF COUNTY FACILITIES AND ATTENDANCE AT COUNTY EVENTS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Chapter 95 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended by expanding thereto the authority of the County Manager to discount fees and offer group rates to events at county facilities. The chapter shall read as follows:

95.370 Payment for use of facilities.

- 1. No person shall use, occupy or be within the boundaries of any facility for which a fee has been established by the board of county commissioners or the county manager without having first paid the required fee.
- 2. The fees may be collected by a park ranger, park staff or other authorized personnel in the manner prescribed pursuant to the provisions of section 95.380 of this code.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 95.380 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows.

95.380 Fees; method of establishment and collection.

- 1. The director shall submit to the board of county commissioners a schedule which defines categories and time limits of use facilities within the county park system and which sets forth proposed fees for each category of use. The categories, time limits and fees shall become effective upon entry of an order of the board of county commissioners.
- 2. For marketing or promotional purposes only, the county manager or designee shall have discretion to reduce fees, provide for group rates and membership packages for use of the county facility and to establish new fees for short term programs or exhibits that may occur within the department.
- 3. The director may provide to the board of county commissioners a schedule of proposed fees for the sale or rental of personal property intended for use within a facility of the county park system. The fees shall become effective upon entry of an order of

the board of county commissioners.

4. The director shall also submit a proposed method of collection of fees, which method will minimize collection costs and maximize revenues.
