

SUMMARY: An ordinance amending the Washoe County Code to change the membership of the Senior Services advisory board.

ORDINANCE NO. 1459

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 45 TO CHANGE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SENIOR SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD BY CONVERTING CERTAIN MEMBERS TO NON-VOTING MEMBERS, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 45.415 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended in subsection 2 as follows:

45.415 Advisory board; membership; appointment; qualifications; terms; compensation.

1. An advisory board shall be created to consist of not less than 7 nor more than 11 members and 3 non-voting ex officio members.
2. Except as otherwise provided herein, any person appointed must be a resident of Washoe County and have an interest in civic affairs, including but not limited to an interest or experience in the fields of nutrition, geriatric social work, administration, finance, and law. The three non-voting ex officio appointments, whom shall serve as liaisons to the advisory board, shall be made, one each, by the Reno City Council, Sparks City Council and Washoe County Commission from within their respective memberships.
3. Members of the advisory board shall be appointed by the board of county commissioners.
4. Advisory board members shall be appointed for a four year term and may serve, with reappointment, a maximum of two consecutive terms.
5. An advisory board member may be removed by the board of county commissioners for cause. For purposes of this section, "cause" includes three consecutive unexcused absences from advisory board meetings and the engaging in activities contrary to the mission, goals or objectives of the department.
6. Appointed advisory board members serve at the pleasure of the board of county commissioners.




