AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING AND AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE AUTHORITY'S RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THE GENERAL OBLIGATION (LIMITED TAX) RENO-SPARKS CONVENTION & VISITORS AUTHORITY REFUNDING BONDS (ADDITIONALLY SECURED WITH PLEDGED REVENUES), **SERIES** 2021 IN THE **MAXIMUM** PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$70,000,000; **RATIFYING** ACTION TAKEN, **APPROVING** AND CONFIRMING ACTION TAKEN IN THE **AUTHORITY'S** TO BE FINANCING AND IN THE IMPOSITION, COLLECTION AND ASSIGNMENT OF ROOM TAXES AND THE PLEDGE OF SUCH TAXES TO THE BONDS; PRESCRIBING OTHER DETAILS IN CONNECTION HEREWITH; AND **PROVIDING** ITS **ADOPTION FOR** AS EMERGENCY EXISTS AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

- (1) **WHEREAS**, the County of Washoe, in the State of Nevada ("County" and "State," respectively), is a political subdivision under the laws of the State; and
- (2) **WHEREAS**, the Reno-Sparks Convention & Visitors Authority (the "Authority") is authorized pursuant to NRS 244A.637 to issue general obligation bonds additionally secured by pledged revenues in the name of and on behalf of the County; and
- (3) **WHEREAS**, the Authority has requested the Board of County Commissioners of the County (the "Board") to consent by ordinance to the issuance and payment of the Washoe County, Nevada General Obligation (Limited Tax) Reno-Sparks Convention & Visitors Authority Refunding Bonds (Additionally Secured with Pledged Revenues), Series 2021 (the "2021 Bonds"); and
- (4) **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the NRS 244A.597 to 244A.655 as amended (the "Recreation Act") and NRS 350.500 to 350.720 as amended (the "Bond Act"), the Authority adopted a resolution authorizing the issuance of the 2021 Bonds, a copy of which has been filed with the County Clerk (the "Refunding Bond Resolution"); and
- (5) **WHEREAS,** Section 4.7 of the Reno-Sparks Convention & Visitors Authority Washoe County Cooperative Agreement Regarding General Obligation Backing of

Bonds dated November 23, 1999, as amended (the "Cooperative Agreement") states that "[p]rior to incurring additional medium or long-term debt, which includes, but is not limited to bank loans and revenue bonds or any other obligations that cause the authority to pledge or be payable from any legally available funding for more than one year, the Authority will be required to have available revenue, not pledged for existing debt payments or required to be deposited into the Sinking Fund, or required for necessary ongoing Authority operating expenses that is two (2) times the annual payment of the proposed debt or obligation, and upon written request from the Authority, the County may modify or waive this requirement"; and

(6) **WHEREAS,** the Authority has requested in writing that the County waive the provisions of Section 4.7 of the Cooperative Agreement as to the 2021 Bonds, thereby allowing the Authority to issue the 2021 Bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, DO ORDAIN:

- Section 1. <u>Short Title</u>. This resolution shall be designated by the short title "2021 RSCVA Ratification Ordinance".
- Section 2. <u>Ratification and Authorization of 2021 Bonds</u>. All action heretofore taken by the Board and by the Authority in the sale and issuance of the 2021 Bonds, is hereby ratified; the adoption of the Refunding Bond Resolution by the Authority is hereby approved and confirmed; and the 2021 Bonds are hereby authorized to be issued.
- Section 3. <u>Agreement to the Refunding Bond Resolution</u>. The County consents to and agrees to be bound by the provisions of the Refunding Bond Resolution, and waives the requirements of Section 4.7 of the Cooperative Agreement.
- Section 4. <u>Filing Ordinance</u>. A certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed forthwith with the Secretary of the Authority.
- Section 5. <u>Ordinance Irrepealable</u>. This ordinance shall be and shall remain irrepealable until the 2021 Bonds or any bonds refunding the 2021 Bonds shall be fully paid, canceled and discharged, or until provision shall be made therefor, in the manner provided in the Refunding Bond Resolution.
- Section 6. <u>Publication and Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication as hereinafter provided, and after this ordinance is signed by the Chair of the Board and attested and sealed by the County Clerk, this ordinance shall be published by title only, together with the names of the Commissioners voting for or against its passage, and with a statement that typewritten copies of the ordinance are available for inspection by all interested parties at the office of the County Clerk. Such publication is to be made in the <u>Reno Gazette-Journal</u>, a newspaper published and having general circulation in the County, at least once a week for a period of two (2) weeks by two (2) insertions, pursuant to NRS 244.100 and all laws thereunto enabling, such publication is to be in substantially the following form:

In Person and Online Viewing. Public Comment. Public comment, whether on action items or general public comment, is limited to three (3) minutes per person. No action may be taken on a matter raised under general public comment until the matter is included on an agenda as an item on which action may be taken. The County will make reasonable efforts to include all comments received by 4:00pm on March 8, 2021 by email and voicemail into the record. Comments are limited to 3 minutes per person and will be entered into the record only. Voicemails will no longer be played for broadcast and emails will not be read by the Clerk.

Technical Difficulties. Public Comment Time Limits. Public comments are welcomed during the Public Comment periods for all matters, whether listed on the agenda or not, and are limited to three minutes per person. Additionally, public comment of three minutes per person will be heard during individually numbered items designated as "for possible action" on the agenda; public comment during individual action items must be relevant to the particular item being considered. Persons are invited to submit comments in writing on the agenda items and/or attend and make comment on that item at the Commission meeting. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers.

Responses to Public Comments. The County Commission can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. During the public comment period, speakers may address matters listed or not listed on the published agenda. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by the Commission. However, responses from Commissioners to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. On the advice of legal counsel and to ensure the public has notice of all matters the Commission will consider, Commissioners may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for County staff action or to ask that a matter be listed on a future agenda. The Commission may do this either during the public comment item or during the following item "Commissioners'/County Manager's announcements, reports and updates, requested for information or topics for future agendas.".

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business. The Board of County Commissioners conducts the business of Washoe County and its citizens during its meetings. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.

NOTE: Items on the agenda may be taken out of order; combined with other items; removed from the agenda; moved to the agenda of another meeting; moved to or from the Consent section; or may be voted on in a block. Items with a specific time designation will not be heard prior to the stated time, but may be heard later. The Consent item is a single agenda item, is considered as a block, and will not be read aloud. The Board of County Commissioners may take breaks approximately every 90 minutes.
