Description

Administrative Permit Case Number AP14-004 (Incline Village Fine Art Festival) — To approve an administrative permit and outdoor community event business license for the Incline Village Fine Art Festival, an outdoor art display event to be held at Preston Field in Incline Village, Nevada on August 15, 16, and 17, 2014. The proposed event will be held between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. (Friday through Sunday). The event will consist of approximately 50 artists, three food booths, acoustic entertainment (no amplification or stages), and possible wine tasting. Each artist will set up their own 10' x 10' canopy in which to display their original art work. Primary parking is proposed on-site utilizing the existing parking for Preston Field. Event organizers estimate that approximately 50 participants and a maximum of 500 spectators will take part in the event during any one day of the three-day event period. Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, to include the report of reviewing agencies, the Board of Adjustment may approve the issuance of the administrative permit and business license with conditions, or deny the application.


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Administrative Permit Definition

The purpose of an Administrative Permit is to provide a method of review for a proposed use which possess characteristics that requires a thorough appraisal in order to determine if the use has the potential to adversely affect other land uses, transportation or facilities in the vicinity. The Board of Adjustment may require conditions of approval necessary to eliminate, mitigate, or minimize to an acceptable level any potentially adverse effects of a use, or to specify the terms under which commencement and operation of the use must comply. Prior to approving an application for an administrative permit, the Board of Adjustment must find that all of the required findings, if applicable, are true.

The Conditions of Approval for Administrative Permit Case Number AP14-004 is attached to this staff report and will be included with the Action Order.




VICINITY AND NOTICING MAP



Project Evaluation

The Incline Village Fine Art Festival is planned to be held at Preston Field, which is a single softball/baseball field surrounded by a small park located near the intersection of the Mt. Rose Hwy. and Tahoe Blvd. As shown in the above site plan, the main portion of the event will be held on the softball field where a series of 10' x 10' canopies will be set up for the display of art. Surrounding land uses include residential dwellings to the east (Winding Wood subdivision), a church to the north (on a large parcel, most of which is vacant near the event site), Tahoe Blvd. to the south, and to the west is the Washoe County and Nevada Department of Transportation public works yards. The residential parcels to the east are directly adjacent to the event location/Preston Field.

The event will be held during the day, Friday through Sunday, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Although acoustic entertainment may be provided, there will be no amplification or music stages. Canopies will remain set up overnight with overnight security provided, but no nighttime illumination will occur. The event location, Preston Field, has existing parking, permanent toilet facilities, potable water, and direct access from Tahoe Blvd. The event organizers intend to provide additional portable toilets and trash receptacles, to include a dumpster.

In addition to the art displays, there will be three food booths and possible wine tasting. Admission to the event and parking will be free to the public. When the event ends Sunday at 5:00 p.m., the artists will break down their displays and must be gone by 9:00 p.m. (at the latest) and the grounds cleaned. The organizers, West Coast Artists Corporation, claim the event will benefit a local non-profit organization. West Coast Artists Corporation, also a 501(c) non-profit, has been producing art shows since 1983 and has done over 300 shows to date.

There is only one parking lot at Preston Field to utilize for all event parking (and potentially for any public visiting the park facilities). Staff estimates that this lot has a total of 34 paved parking spaces. The event organizers claim in their application that additional parking, if needed, can be supplied by "the business behind Preston Field," or off-site along Tahoe Blvd. or on the dirt road running along the site property line/power line. Staff cannot identify, however, any such business. The only adjacent off-site parking staff can identify is in the Washoe County Public Works Yard, which is not available for public parking. Off-site parking along either NDOT roadway is not acceptable for safety and environmental reasons. Therefore, conditions of approval shall require that all parking be provided on-site on paved surfaces (see attached Conditions of Approval).

No other Conditions of Approval have been requested by the reviewing agencies. Although the NLTFPD had no conditions of approval regarding this Administrative Permit, the applicant will be required to obtain a separate event permit from the NLTFPD. Conditions of approval will be categorized into pre-event, during-event, and after-event conditions. The Planning and Development Division will ensure that the applicant complies with all Conditions of Approval. Other permits required for the event, such as for the food booths or wine tasting, will be enforced by the respective permitting agencies.

Incline Village/Crystal Bay Citizen Advisory Board

Administrative Permits are not required by Washoe County Code to be presented at a Citizen Advisory Board meeting. However, the Incline Village/Crystal Bay CAB members were noticed of this BOA meeting following the provisions outlined in WCC Chapter 110, 10 days prior to the Public Hearing.

Staff Comment on Required Findings

Section 110.808.25 of Article 808, *Administrative Permits*, within the Washoe County Development Code, requires that all of the following findings be made to the satisfaction of the Washoe County Board of Adjustment before granting approval of the Administrative Permit request. Staff has completed an analysis of the application and has determined that the proposal is in compliance with the required findings as follows:

1. <u>Consistency.</u> That the proposed use is consistent with the action programs, policies, standards and maps of the Master Plan and the Tahoe Area Plan.

<u>Staff Comment</u>: The proposed outdoor community event, a Fine Art Festival to be conducted on the grounds of Preston Field, is a permitted use with approval of an Administrative Permit and business license. There are no programs policies maps or standards in any of the relevant Washoe County Plans that are inconsistent with this use.

 Improvements. That adequate utilities, roadway improvements, sanitation, water supply, drainage, and other necessary facilities have been provided, the proposed improvements are properly related to existing and proposed roadways, and an adequate public facilities determination has been made in accordance with Division Seven.

<u>Staff Comment:</u> The administrative permit review process ensures that Washoe County staff, and that of other appropriate agencies, apply conditions to this use that will ensure that all of the above mentioned improvements, services and facilities are provided for this event. Staff is confident that the necessary facilities are in place or will be in place as the result of conditions of approval for the duration of the event.

- 3. <u>Site Suitability.</u> That the site is physically suitable for an Outdoor Community Event, and for the intensity of such a development.
 - <u>Staff Comment:</u> The proposed site appears suitable for the event. Preston Field and associated facilities provides adequate space and a large lawn area capable of hosting the expected crowds and artist displays. There is adequate room for the set up of the necessary facilities and equipment. Staff is not aware if similar events have previously been held at this location, but IVGID has agreed to rent the facilities for the event, has reviewed the application, and had no comments.
- 4. <u>Issuance Not Detrimental.</u> That issuance of the permit will not be significantly detrimental to the public health, safety or welfare; injurious to the property or improvements of adjacent properties; or detrimental to the character of the surrounding area.
 - <u>Staff Comment:</u> The administrative permit review process ensures that all appropriate agencies have provided all necessary conditions for this event to remain non detrimental to the public health safety and welfare of the area, nor will surrounding properties be unduly injured nor will the character of the surrounding area be harmed. As an active recreation facility, nearby residents should be acclimated to crowds using this facility. In addition, no night time illumination will occur, there will be no amplified music, and hours of operation are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- 5. <u>Effect on a Military Installation.</u> Issuance of the permit will not have a detrimental effect on the location, purpose or mission of the military installation.
 - <u>Staff Comment:</u> Not applicable there are no military installations within 3,000 feet.

Recommendation

Agencies which reviewed the application recommended conditions of approval in support of the project. Therefore, after a thorough analysis and review staff is recommending approval, with conditions, of Administrative Permit Case Number AP14-004 and the associated Outdoor Community Event business license.

Should the Board of Adjustment approve the issuance of the permit and license, staff recommends that the applicant provide Washoe County Business License with proof of compliance for each applicable condition by August 1, 2014. Washoe County Business License will issue the Community Events business license, under the signature of the Division Director, only after determination that all conditions have been met and that all applicable fees and deposits have been paid (WCC Section 25.283).

Motion

I move that after giving reasoned consideration to the information contained in the staff report and information received during the public hearing, the Board of Adjustment approves with conditions, Administrative Permit Case Number AP14-004, and the accompanying Outdoor Community Event business license, for the Incline Village Fine Arts Festival, having made all five findings in accordance with Washoe County Development Code Section 110.808.25, and further authorize the Planning and Development Director to sign the business license after all appropriate conditions have been met or satisfied.

- 1. <u>Consistency.</u> That the proposed use is consistent with the action programs, policies, standards and maps of the Master Plan, Tahoe Area Plan and the Incline Village Tourist Community Plan;
- 2. <u>Improvements.</u> That adequate utilities, roadway improvements, sanitation, water supply, drainage, and other necessary facilities have been provided, the proposed improvements are properly related to existing and proposed roadways, and an adequate public facilities determination has been made in accordance with Division Seven:
- 3. <u>Site Suitability.</u> That the site is physically suitable for an outdoor concert series and for the intensity of such a development;
- 4. <u>Issuance Not Detrimental.</u> That issuance of the permit will not be significantly detrimental to the public health, safety or welfare; injurious to the property or improvements of adjacent properties; or detrimental to the character of the surrounding area; and
- 5. <u>Effect on a Military Installation.</u> Issuance of the permit will not have a detrimental effect on the location, purpose or mission of the military installation.

Appeal Process

Board of Adjustment action will be effective 15 days after the public hearing, unless the action is appealed to the County Commission, in which case the outcome of the appeal shall be determined by the Washoe County Commission.

Conditions of Approval

Administrative Permit Case Number AP14-004

The project approved under Administrative Permit Case Number AP14-004 shall be carried out in accordance with the Conditions of Approval granted by the Board of Adjustment on June 5, 2014. The Board of Adjustment has established conditions which must be met prior to the issuance of an Outdoor Community Event License pursuant to Washoe county Code, Article 25. Conditions of Approval are requirements placed on a permit or development by each reviewing agency. These Conditions of Approval may require submittal of documents, applications, fees, inspections, amendments to plans, and more. These conditions do not relieve the applicant of the obligation to obtain any other approvals and licenses from relevant authorities required under any other act.

<u>Unless otherwise specified</u>, all conditions related to the approval of this Administrative Permit shall be met or financial assurance must be provided to satisfy the conditions of approval prior to August 1, 2014. The agency responsible for determining compliance with a specific condition shall determine whether the condition must be fully completed or whether the applicant shall be offered the option of providing financial assurance. All agreements or other documentation required by these conditions shall have a copy filed with the Planning and Development Division.

Compliance with the Conditions of Approval related to this Administrative Permit and Business License is the responsibility of the Licensee at the Licensee's Expense. Failure to comply with any of the conditions imposed in the approval of the Administrative Permit may cause Washoe County to not issue the business license or for the County to take appropriate measures to revoke or suspend the business license.

Washoe County reserves the right to review and revise the conditions of approval related to this Administrative Permit should it be determined that a subsequent license or permit issued by Washoe County violates the intent of this approval.

For the purpose of conditions imposed by Washoe County, "may" is permissive and "shall" or "must" is mandatory.

Conditions of Approval are usually complied with at different stages of the proposed project. Those stages are typically:

- Prior to permit issuance of the business license.
- Prior to obtaining a final inspection and/or a certificate of occupancy.
- Prior to the issuance of a business license or other permits/licenses.
- Some "Conditions of Approval" are referred to as "Operational Conditions." These conditions must be continually complied with for the life of the project or business.

THE APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT ALL REQUIRED PLANS, PERMITS, DOCUMENTATION, ETC., TO THE IDENTIFIED RESPONSIBLE AGENCY. THE APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE WASHOE COUNTY BUSINESS LICENSE WITH PROOF OF COMPLICANT WITH ALL APPLICAPABLE CONDITONS BY AUGUST 1, 2014. WASHOE COUNTY BUSINESS LICENSE WILL ISSUE THE OUTDOOR COMMUNITY EVENT BUSINESS LICENSE AFTER

DETERMINING THAT ALL OF THESE CONDTIONS HAVE BEEN MET AND THAT ALL APPLICABLE FEES AND DEPOSITS HAVE BEEN PAID.

The Washoe County Commission oversees many of the reviewing agencies/departments with the exception of the following agencies.

- The DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH, through the Washoe County Health District, has jurisdiction over all public health matters in the Health District. Any conditions set by the District Health Department must be appealed to the District Board of Health.
- The RENO-TAHOE AIRPORT AUTHORITY is directed and governed by its own Board. Therefore, any conditions set by the Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority must be appealed to their Board of Trustees.
- The REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (RTC) is directed and governed by its own board. Therefore, any conditions set by the Regional Transportation Commission must be appealed to that Board.

FOLLOWING ARE CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL REQUIRED BY THE REVIEWING AGENCIES. EACH CONDITION MUST BE MET TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE ISSUING AGENCY.

Washoe County Planning and Development

1. The following conditions are requirements of the Planning and Development Division, which shall be responsible for determining compliance with these conditions.

- a. The following **pre-event** conditions shall be required for the approved Outdoor Community Event:
 - 1. The applicant shall attach a copy of the Action Order approving this project to all administrative permit applications (including the NLTFPD event permit) applied for as part of this Administrative Permit.
 - 2. An Outdoor Community Event license for the Incline Village Fine Art Festival shall be issued prior to commencing display of art.
 - 3. Any food and/or beverage concessions shall obtain appropriate Washoe County Health food service, business, and intoxicating liquor licenses.
 - 4. **By August 1, 2014** the applicant shall notify Planning and Development that all **pre-event Conditions of Approval** have been met. Upon notification, Planning and Development staff will conduct an inspection to verify compliance. Inspection shall be random and unannounced.
- b. The following **Operational Conditions (i.e. during and after event)** shall be required for the approved dates of the Outdoor Community Event:

Date: May 25, 2012

1. The applicant shall demonstrate substantial conformance to the site plans approved as part of this Administrative Permit. The Planning and Development Division shall determine compliance with this condition.

Date: May 25, 2012

- 2. <u>Hours of Operation.</u> The event shall take place between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Event set up activities shall not occur before 8:00 a.m. At the end of the event, all activities (to include clean-up and trash removal) shall cease by 9:00 p.m.
- 3. <u>Noise.</u> Only acoustic music shall be provided. No amplified music or stages are allowed during the event.
- 4. Restroom Facilities Must be open and available to the public during the entire time of the event. Additional portable toilets shall be provided on site to augment the existing permanent facilities and shall be removed when the event ends.
- 5. Lighting. No lighting shall be used.
- 6. <u>Parking.</u> Parking shall be provided by the existing on-site paved parking lot. Parking shall only be allowed on paved surfaces. The informal dirt road adjacent to the softball field shall not be used for parking, nor shall any NDOT road right-of-way be used for parking.
- 7. <u>Clean up</u>. The applicant shall be responsible for total cleanup of the site, returning it to the pre-event condition.
- 8. Failure to comply with the conditions of approval shall render this approval null and void.

North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District (NLTFPD)

The following pre-event conditions are requirements of the NLTFPD, which shall be responsible for determining compliance with these conditions. The NLTFPD is directed and governed by its own board. Therefore, any conditions set by the NLTFPD must be appealed to that board. The applicant shall provide all required documentation showing proof of compliance with Condition "a" by August 1, 2014.

Incline Village Fine Art Festival Preston Field August 15 – 17, 2014

Event Plan

The "Incline Village Fine Art Festival" is planned for August 15 – 17, 2014. The location will be Preston Field, Incline Village, NV. The event will consist of approximately 50 artists, 3 food booths; wine tasting (if approved) and acoustic entertainment (no amplification, no stages). Each artist will set-up their own 10' X 10' canopy, in which they will display their original artwork over a course of three days.

The canopies will remain set-up overnight and there will be overnight security provided to watch over the displays.

Preston Field has ample parking for the event, has permanent toilet and hand washing facilities, and potable water available to the patrons of the event. An information/First Aid station will be set-up in case of an emergency.

The hours of the event will be from 10:00 am until 5:00 pm. Daylight hours only, so there is no need for night time illumination. All members of the staff have cell phones for communication. No overnight camping will be approved for Preston Field.







Vicinity Map and Surrounding Uses




Site Plan

Analysis

- Bathrooms exist on site, but additional portable toilets will also be provided
- There are homes directly adjacent to the event location
- Overnight security will be provided to guard event set up (but no illumination)
- One parking lot available on site with approximately 43 parking spaces

Analysis

- The applicant has proposed using an adjacent dirt road for vendor parking
- Overflow/additional parking proposed at "adjacent business" or along Tahoe Blvd
- Such areas are not officially available for event parking – parking must be in the paved lot
- North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District will issue a separate event license
