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Ms. Sannazzaro opened the public hearing.

Kelly Mullin gave an overview of her staff report dated August 25, 2015. Amy Ray, with Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District (TMFPD) and also the project applicant, submitted generic comments that would be used for any project in the County, at this time as they were not in the staff report. Ms. Ray will abstain from voting on the item as she is part of TMFPD.

Ms. Sannazzaro opened public comment; being none, public comment period was closed.

Mike Gump moved that, after giving reasoned consideration to the information contained within the staff report and the information received during the public meeting, that the Washoe County Parcel Map Review Committee approve Parcel Map Case Number PM15-013 for Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District, which has determined that the following criteria is or will be adequately provided for pursuant to Washoe County Development Code, Section 110.606.30 including the comments submitted by TMFPD. Mr. Simpson seconded the motion which passed with 5 members voting for and 1 member abstaining.

The motion carried and considered the following criteria:

- 1) General improvement considerations for all parcel maps including, but not limited to:
 - a) Environmental and health laws and regulations concerning water and air pollution, the disposal of solid waste, facilities to supply water, community or public sewage disposal and, where applicable, individual systems for sewage disposal;
 - b) The availability of water which meets applicable health standards and is sufficient for the reasonably foreseeable needs of the subdivision;
 - c) The availability and accessibility of utilities;
 - d) The availability and accessibility of public services such as schools, police and fire protection, transportation, recreation and parks;
 - e) Conformity with the zoning ordinances and master plan;
 - f) General conformity with the governing body's master plan of streets and highways;
 - g) The effect of the proposed subdivision on existing public streets and the need for new streets or highways to serve the subdivision;
 - h) Physical characteristics of the land such as floodplain, slope and soil;
 - i) The recommendations and comments of those entities reviewing the tentative parcel map pursuant to NRS 278.330 and 278.348, inclusive;
 - j) The availability and accessibility of fire protection including, but not limited to, the availability and accessibility of water and services for the prevention and containment of fires including fires in wild lands;
 - k) Community antenna television (CATV) conduit and pull wire; and
 - I) Recreation and trail easements.
