- Update on Weston property and lawsuits, including an update from the February 9, 2010 Washoe County Commission meeting.
- Retaining fire and emergency service at current levels at Bower's Fire Station, fire service consolidation as proposed in the recent Damonte study, fire service issues discussed at the March 23<sup>rd</sup> Washoe County Commission meeting, discussion regarding participation at the April 13<sup>th</sup> Washoe County Commission meeting, and what are the next steps?
- Conversion to a two-map process for master planning and zoning.
