  - a. Discuss the pros and cons of developing a General Improvement District (GID) to address the short falls and county's equity in funding fire and emergency services in Washoe Valley.
  - b. Establishing a trust fund for legal defense of fire and medical services for the citizen's of West Washoe Valley.
- Discuss fundraisers and requests for donations to the volunteer fire services in Washoe Valley.
- West Washoe Association's annual picnic in August.
- Ongoing updates regarding Weston property and lawsuits.
