During the discussion it was noted that the flights have to occur at various times to view the mountainous areas without snow and the lower elevations once the leaves have dropped. As the discussion continued, it was suggested that the 2019 flight be pushed to the fall and that a spring 2020 is not out of the question, but not the desired option.
