Egg Carton Bird Feeder

Materials:

- Egg carton
- String, twine, yarn, etc.
- Scissors
- Birdseed/food

Directions:

- 1. You can either cut your egg carton into smaller sections or leave it one piece; this part is up to you. I had a carton that could hold 18 eggs, so I cut it into three smaller pieces.
- 2. On each corner of your carton(s) poke a small hole with your scissors. This is where the string will thread through.



- 3. Cut 4 pieces of string of equal length. The length is up to you.
- 4. Thread a piece of string through each hole created in the corners of the carton. Tie the piece of thread to the carton. Double or triple know it so it is secure.



- 5. Go outside and find a limb to tie the feeder to. (It's best to tie it after choosing your limb so you don't have to wiggle it over/around branches that may be in the way.)
- 6. Fill the feeder with bird seed.



7. Watch as birds come to their new feeder to eat!
