

EGGHEAD PLANTERS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Eggs
- Soil
- Grass seeds
- Water
- Permanent marker



INSTRUCTIONS:

- Boil some eggs. Place eggs and water in saucepans and bring to a boil. Turn the stove off when water starts to boil and leave eggs in the hot water for 15 minutes.
- 2. Once the eggs have cooled, chop off the top of the eggs and gently scoop the egg out of the shell with a small spoon.
- 3. Draw the face on the eggshell using permanent marker.
- 4. Sprinkle soil into the shell until it is 3/4 full.
- 5. Add a good layer of grass seeds and then sprinkle soil on top of the seeds.
- 6. Water every day and keep it in the sun.
- 7. Within a few days grass should start sprouting! Give your eggheads a "haircut" every few days and watch as it grows back!
