Sensory Leaf Paint

Materials:

- Leaf outline print off
- Construction paper
- Sandwich sized zip locks
- Paint
- Scissors (or box cutter)
- Pencil
- Masking tape



Directions:

1. Print off the Leaf Outline PDF. Cut out the leaves.



2. Trace the leaves onto a sheet construction paper.



3. Cut out the shape of the leaf on the construction paper. (This can be a little tedious.)



4. In the zip lock bag, squirt multiple colors of paint into the baggie. You won't need a ton but enough to push around in the bag. Gently push the air out of the bag a seal shut.



5. On one side of the construction paper, tape the zip lock bag filled with paint to the paper.



- 6. Flip over and let your little one push the paint around.
 - a. You can do many things with this such as: making letters, shapes, numbers, etc.
