SPONGE SPROUT HOUSE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- 4 regular sponges
- Scissors
- · Glue or toothpicks
- Seeds (grass, chia, cress)
- Water
- · Plate
- · Spray bottle

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Rinse off your sponges. You will want them moist while making the house.
- 2. Leave one sponge whole (base of the house), cut one sponge in half (the side walls of the house), cut the third sponge half and then cut in half once again (the front and back walls of the house), and cut the forth sponge partially in half so the whole sponge remains together but you can easily bend the sponge (this will be the roof of the house).
- 3. Hot glue the sides of the house together and then hot glue to the sponge that was left whole. Next, hot glue the roof on. You made need to hold the pieces in place after gluing to ensure that all pieces stick together.
- 4. Mix you seeds with a little bit of water. Use a spoon or a butter knife to spread the seeds onto the sponge used as a base and on the sponge that is used as the roof. Set your sprout house on a plate.
- 5. Spray the seeds multiple times throughout the day to keep them moist.
- 6. In a few days, your seeds should sprout and grow!
