- Share facts about the mental, physical, and emotional health benefits of social connection and how it contributes to overall well-being.
- Promote resources that help older adults engage, like community events, social clubs, and volunteer opportunities.
- Connect older adults with local services, such as transportation, that can help them overcome obstacles to achieving or maintaining meaningful relationships.
- Encourage partners to host a connection-centric event or program focused on older adult mentors to youth, peer-to-peer support, or similar efforts.
- Challenge professional and personal networks to prioritize meaningful social connections and share the benefits.
- Inspire older adults to share what connection means to them on social media using the hashtag #PoweredByConnection.

Transportation Options

Do you want to attend Older Americans Month events, but don't know how you will get there? Our community partners are here to help!

RTC FlexRIDE- In addition to regular bus routes all over Washoe County, RTC has free rides for seniors 60+ on the Sparks/Spanish Springs curb-to-curb FlexRIDE vans until June 30, 2024. See https://rtcwashoe.com/public-transportation/flexride-on-demand-service/ or call 775 335 0035 to schedule rides. FlexRIDE for seniors age 60+ in North Valleys, Northwest Reno and starting in May 2024 in south Reno, costs \$1.50 for a day pass. Put funds on your RTC mobile Token Transit app or buy tickets in advance at bus terminals, 9th Street Senior Center, Savemart, Winco, or Smiths. Call 775 348 0477

RTC Senior Ride/Taxi Bucks/Lyft/Uber: RTC offers \$60 per month of free taxi rides inside Washoe County to residents 60+, veterans or ACCESS clients of any age. Apply in-person at RTC's 4th Street Reno terminal. Those with Lyft or Uber accounts, can get \$60 per month of free Lyft or Uber rides instead of taxis. Neighbor Network of Northern Nevada (N4) offers Reno/Sparks elders 60+ a monthly \$80 of free Lyft rides inside Washoe County, and another \$80 worth for \$40. Folks with disabilities of any age pay \$40 for \$80 of Lyft monthly. 775 453 4774 https://neighbornv.org/

Access to Health Care has free transportation for folks with Medicare to medical appointments, getting prescriptions and groceries. 877 385 2345 www.accesstohealthcare.org. Check with your own medical plan to see if they offer this benefit. Call 2-1-1 for more statewide services.

UNR's Sanford Center for Aging offers free transportation for Washoe residents 60+ who live within 15 miles of UNR main campus and need transportation for medical appointments, groceries, or errands. Contact them 14 days ahead at 775 784 7557 or sanfordmobility@unr.edu. Sanford also offers free wellness programs and medication management for seniors.


