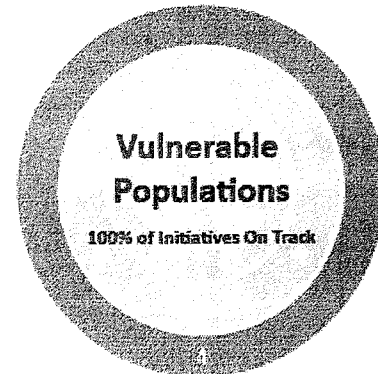

FY18 Accomplishments

- Completed the Hope house with collaboration with Grace Church to help mothers recovering from substance abuse and working towards reunification with their children.
- 17% increase in adoptions in FY 2018 from the previous year.
- Implemented a new CPS hotline number and upgraded HSA's intake phone reporting system to enhance how new incoming reports of child abuse and neglect are processed within the agency.
- Opened the Incline Community Center targeted to seniors in need. The center will host senior and community activities in Incline Village, helping remove isolation and service access barriers that directly affect quality of life for senior populations. The center also provides an additional community resource next to the Incline Library for residents to access government services.
- Created the new Human Services Resource Guide to catalog regional resources and identify/target gaps in service.
- Developed and launched a Sudden Unexplained Infant Deaths campaign to reduce the number of infant deaths in Washoe County.
