Through critical home repairs and home modifications in underserved communities, we address the connection between health and housing while preserving the existing affordable housing landscape across the US.

WHO WE SERVE

Rebuilding Together Northern Nevada (RTNNV) serves low- and moderate-income homeowners in need of critical health and safety repairs focusing on:

- ◆ Seniors
- ◆ Veterans and active duty military and families
- ◆ Persons with disabilities
- ◆ Families with children
- ◆ Victims of natural disasters

As the cost of living increases, many families are forced to choose between daily essentials—such as food, utilities and healthcare—and urgent and basic maintenance to the family home. Our programs help ease the burden of making those tough decisions by offering home repair services at no cost to eligible homeowners.

By repairing existing properties, we preserve affordable housing and prevent neighborhood blight while protecting the homeowner's independence and ability to sustain their main source of personal wealth, their home.



HOW WE DO OUR WORK

Our work is primarily done by community volunteers and licensed contractors. Funding for repairs and renovations comes from the generosity of community organizations, local businesses, civic organizations, corporations, public funding agencies, congregations and individual donors.

ELIGIBILITY

Applications are accepted year-round. We encourage you to visit our website—www.rtnnv.org—to see how our programs and services might be of help to you.

To be eligible for RTNNV-administered home repairs:

- ◆ The home must be a single-family dwelling, manufactured home, mobile home, condominium or townhome located in Washoe County or Carson City
- ◆ The homeowner must:
 - ◇ Own the home where the repairs will be made, live in it as their primary residence and intend to remain in the home for at least two years following the completion of repairs
 - ◇ Have income that does not exceed limits established by the Department of Housing and Urban Development; for income guidelines, go to RTNNV.org/findhelp
 - ◇ Provide proof of current homeowners insurance and property taxes
 - ◇ Be current on mortgage, HOA dues and/or space rent, as applicable

OUR SERVICES

RTNNV is dedicated to providing home repairs that address health and safety issues. These include:

Safe at Home Repairs: Home modifications that include ramps, grab bars, smoke detectors and minor structural changes that provide accessibility

Critical Home Repairs: Repairs include such items as roofing, plumbing, HVAC and electrical repairs, all performed by licensed contractors

[Re]Build Days: Volunteers assist with outside beautification such as yard cleanup and maintenance of home exterior
