

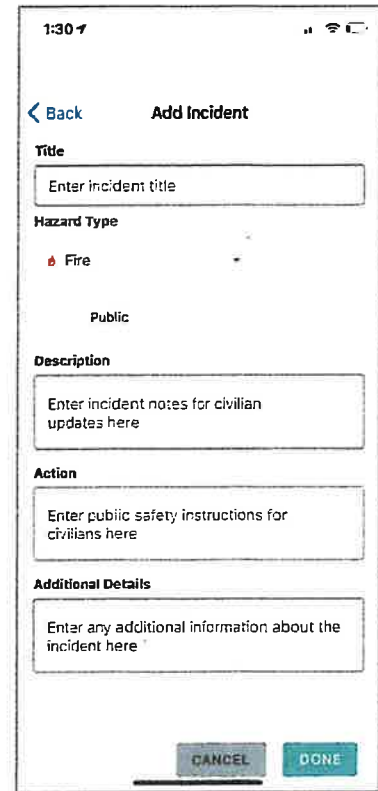
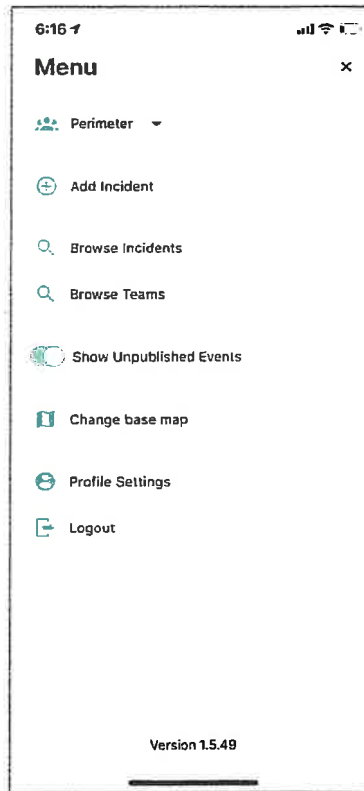
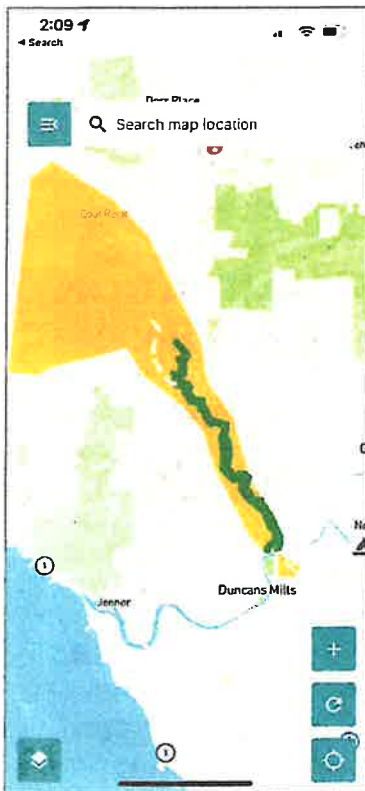
Perimeter is a real-time communication tool to help public safety agencies coordinate during an incident. Users can input incident data to the platform and then share it with first responders, county leaders, or other relevant parties like the local EOC.

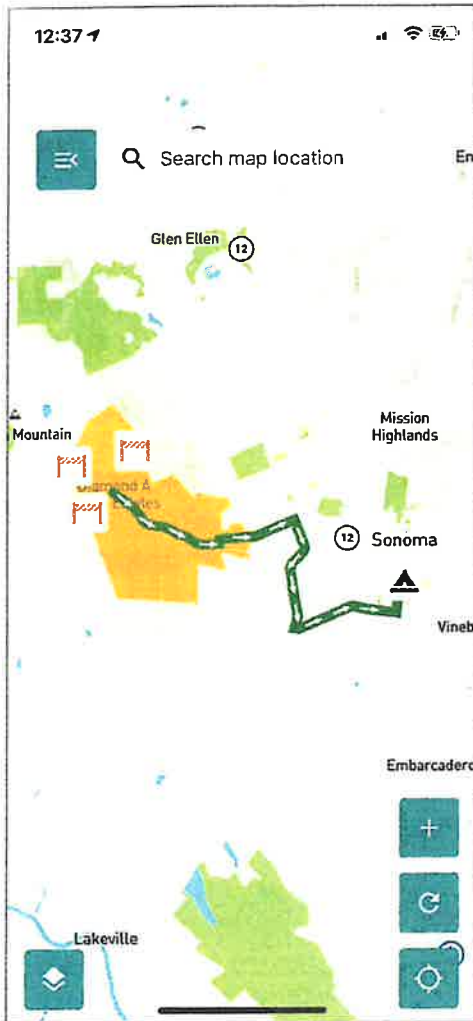
The platform can also store information like a jurisdiction's critical facilities, including details about access and functional needs. Users can then publish information directly to the public during an incident to support evacuations.

## HOW IT WORKS



- 1 Add data points like TEPs, TRAs, and ICPS.
- 2 Add routes for evacuations or road closures.
- 3 Add zones to easily communicate mandatory evacuations and relocations so that residents can take decisive action.

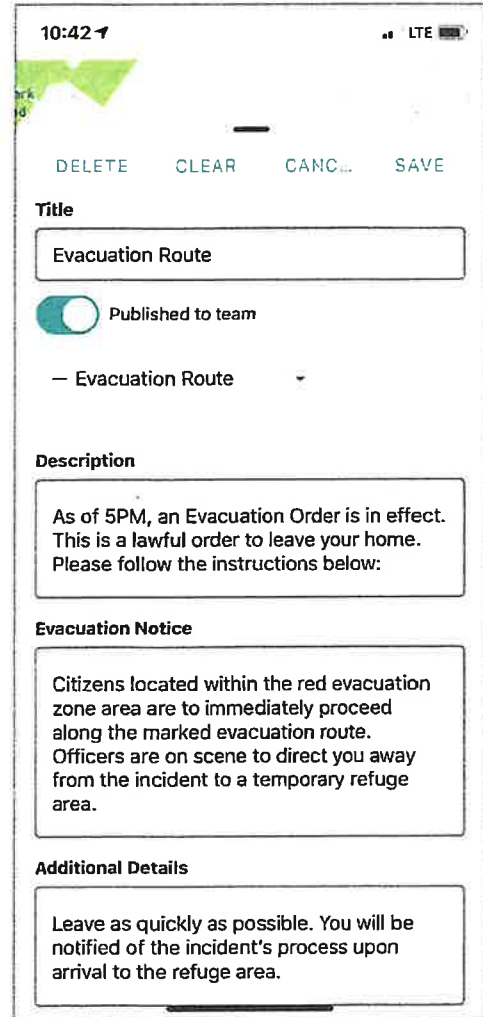




**EVACUATION  
PRE-ATTACK PLANNING**

The County OES can add evacuation zones directly, or import them from a GIS file.

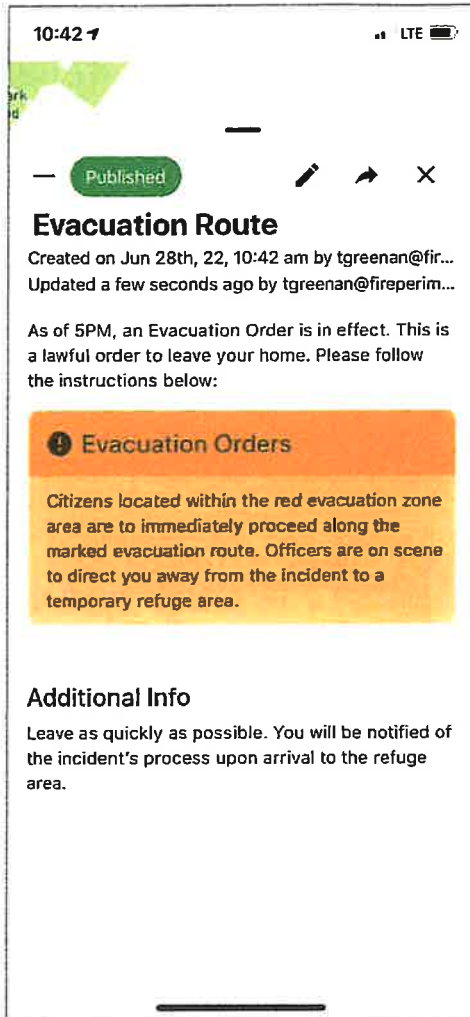
Local departments can input additional data such as hazards, shelters, traffic bottlenecks, etc.



**REAL-TIME EVACUATION  
COORDINATION**

Different agencies can input and view real-time incident updates throughout an evacuation.

For example, the Fire Service can communicate to the Sheriff's Office which area needs to be evacuated or where the fire is, or view which area has an evacuation order in effect.



**PUBLISH EVACUATION INFORMATION**

PIO or other authorized personnel can publish any data to the public in real-time.

Any published data can be updated or unpublished as an incident progresses.



**EASY ACCESS FOR THE PUBLIC**

The public interface is a web application that updates in real-time and can be accessed through a link embedded in an Everbridge alert, a county/city website, or social media posts.

Residents can easily share the web application with others using text messages and social media.
