**ORDER TO SURRENDER FIREARMS
PURSUANT TO NRS 200.481,
NRS 200.485, NRS 202.360, and
18 U.S.C. § 921(a)(33)**

9 Pursuant to the requirements of NRS 200.485, NRS 202.360, and 18 U.S.C. §
10 921(a)(33), you are hereby notified that you are prohibited from owning, possessing, or having
11 under your custody or control any firearm. You are further notified that violation of this Order
12 is a **Category B felony** and shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for a
13 minimum term of not less than one year and a maximum term of not more than six years and
14 may further be punished by a fine of not more than \$5000. Good cause appearing therefore:

15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that you must permanently surrender, sell, or transfer any
16 and all firearms that you own, in your possession, or under your control not later than **24 hours**
17 from the date of this Order, in the following manner, as indicated by the corresponding
18 checkmark:

19 1. Surrender any firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control to the Reno or Sparks
20 Police Departments, Washoe County Sheriff's Office, or another law enforcement
21 agency. The law enforcement agency shall provide you with a receipt which includes a
22 description and serial number of each firearm surrendered; **or**

23 2. Surrender any firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control to the following person:

24 _____ . In this circumstance, you shall

25 provide to this Court and to either the Reno Police Department, Sparks Police
26 Department, Washoe County Sheriff's Office, or another law enforcement agency the
27 name and address of the person to whom each firearm was surrendered, along with a
28 description and serial number of each firearm surrendered; **or**

1 3. Sell or transfer any firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control to a licensed
2 firearm dealer as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 923(a). The licensed firearm dealer shall
3 provide you with a receipt which includes a description and serial number of each
4 firearm surrendered.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that not later than **72 hours or one business day**, which-
6 ever is later, after the surrender, sale, or transfer of any such firearm, you shall provide the
7 receipt and/or documents described in the checked paragraph above to this Court from the
8 person or entity to whom any such firearm was surrendered, sold, or transferred.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event you currently do not own or have any
10 firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control, you shall execute the subsequent Declaration
11 under penalty of perjury.
